1 **SECTION 3.** The Department of Revenue and the Department of Transportation, 2 Division of Motor Vehicles, shall coordinate to continuously update the Organ Donor Registry 3 under G.S. 20-43.2 and shall coordinate for any other purposes consistent with and necessary to 4 the fulfillment of the objectives of this act.

5 **SECTION 4.** This act is effective for tax returns for taxable years beginning on or 6 after January 1, 2026.
